



## Bell Diver 1 Cobalt Blue Auto

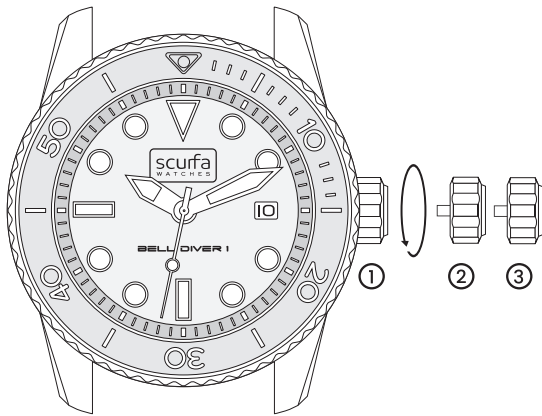
The Bell Diver 1 features a Miyota 9015 automatic movement mounted into a 43mm stainless steel case. The design features a cobalt blue dial, gloss white second hand, polished steel markers and a ceramic bezel. The large markers and luminous highlights make this both functional and fashionable, the perfect choice for use both underwater and in every day life.

## Operating Instructions



Correctly operating your watch it vital to maintaining the quality of the watch and movement.

- 1 Normal Position.
- 2 Date Correction Position.
- 3 Hand Setting Position.

### Calendar Adjustment:

Unscrew the crown counter-clockwise to release the crown before pulling it to position 2. Rotate the crown to adjust the date. Note: The date will change when the time is in the 12 hour PM range, this should be kept in mind when setting the date. Screw the crown clockwise to re-secure the crown & seal the watch.

### Time Adjustment:

Unscrew the crown counter-clockwise to release the crown before pulling it to position 3. Rotate the crown to adjust the time. Note: The calendar date will change if adjusting the time within the 12 hour PM range. Bear this in mind when setting the time to AM or PM. Screw the crown clockwise to re-secure the crown & seal the watch.

### Automatic/Manual Winding

The automatic winding takes place as you move. If necessary, the watch may also be wound by hand by turning the crown in normal position. Wind 15-20 times and it will start to move naturally after shaking slightly.

## Care of your Scurfa watch



### Cleaning your watch

We recommend you use a small soft toothbrush and mild soap, work in with the toothbrush then rinse off with fresh water.

Please check your winding crown is screwed down tight before entering water as damage caused by water entering a loose crown is not covered under warranty.

Always rinse your watch with fresh water after swimming or diving, turn the bezel to dispense of any fine particles that may build up underneath, if your bezel does become tight rinse under warm water and turn to work loose.

### Strap Removal

The tolerances are tight with the Diver One spring bars and the straighter you keep the strap during removal the better, push one side in and move the strap away from the case slightly, push the pin on the opposite side in just enough to move the strap out, keep level then pull the strap downwards, extra care must be taken with the titanium models.

### Strap Fitting

Put one side of the strap/spring bar into the lug, lay the other side level between the lugs, push in the spring bar pin and move the strap into position until the pins spring through the holes, I recommend putting tape on the back of the lugs and use plastic or wood to push the pin into place.

### Using your Diver One in a saturation dive system

Unscrew your crown on any blowdown you may have within your saturation period, decompress your watch at the normal rate, any damage caused by rapid decompression (equipment/medical lock) is not covered under warranty.
